

Sustainable Groundwater Management Act of 2014

- Enacted by state of California in 2015
- Framework for local groundwater basin management
- Brings together all stakeholders agencies, groundwater users, and public
- Groundwater Sustainability Agencies to be formed by June 30, 2017
- Groundwater Sustainability Plan due by January 31, 2022
- Only applies to wells using more than two acre feet of water per year average family of 4 uses less than one acre foot/year



West Placer Groundwater Sustainability Agency

- Covers portion of North American Sub Basin
- Forming Agencies:
 - City of Lincoln
 - City of Roseville
 - Placer County Water Agency (PCWA)
 - Placer County
 - Nevada Irrigation District
 - Cal American Water (Cal Am)
- GSA approved by DWR to implement SGMA in western Placer County.

- Each Agency contributed



- **Prop 1 Grant** (Manage GEI: NASb GW Database)




West Placer County Water Level Conditions Spring 2018









Aquifer response to recent drought conditions





Decline during recent drought: <u>7 feet</u>







GSP Budget and Funding

Budget

 NASb has a \$2M Budget over next 3 years for GSP Development

Funding

- GSAs will cost share by acreage to \$1.1M
 - ➢ WPGSA est. share \$241,000
- Prop 1 Grant: \$900,000 from DWR



GSP Development

(No technical work has started)

- Sacramento GSA is lead for our basin (NASb)
- Consultants competition complete for grant tasks
 - Modeling: Woodard & Curran
 - ➢ GSP development: GEI Consultants
 - ➢ GSP Well Database creation: GEI Consultants
 - Surface water to groundwater database: MBK Engineering
- Project Agreement with DWR taking place
- Consulting agreements to follow



GSP Discussion Items

Public Notification Requirements

(California Water Code Section 10727.8)

"Prior to initiating the development of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) the GSA shall provide a written statement [to DWR] describing the manner in which interested parties may participate in the development and implementation of the GSP to the legislative body of any city or county located within the geographic area of the GSA"

In addition, because of our Memorandum Of Agreement (MOA) between the GSA agency members, we will provide this written statement in a public meeting at each of the agencies + others



Public Notification Process

- Sacramento GSA, as the NASb Coordinator, will send the required Notification to the DWR
- Each WPGSA Agency's elected bodies (plus other land use agencies) will receive the Notification, plus other relevant information, to designate the beginning of the process to develop a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) Project Agreement with DWR
- Public comment/questions of that process will be heard



2018/2019 Schedule


- WPGSA/NASb Agencies: Meetings to announce public Notification for GSP likely in late summer 2018
- WPGSA public meetings: Next update likely late 2018 / early 2019; again in spring and late fall 2019 (dependent on timing of the following)
- **GSP Development results:** Information to be presented at our public meetings
 - > Planning information (what GSP will look like) estimated by the end of 2018
 - > Modeling information (projected future groundwater levels) estimated spring 2019
 - Potential decision points of future groundwater use for each GSA area estimated by late fall of 2019








WY 2018 Monthly Precipitation @ Lake Spaulding






WY 2018 Cumulative Precipitation @ Lake Spaulding




WY 2018 Mar 1 Snow Surveys





WY 2018 American River Basin Snow Sensor Index






Middle Fork Project: Combined Storage






Lake Spaulding/Fordyce Combined Storage
